THE JOURNEY BEGINS WITH A THANK YOU TO OUR HEROES

Heroes sewing masks, starting fundraisers, sending notes of encouragement. Heroes rallying support, spreading hope, equipping the movers and shakers of the moment. When COVID-19 turned the world upside down, Rady Children's community of heroes was there to hold it together.

Through Rady Children's Foundation's partnership with the County of San Diego and Rock Church, our community amassed a collection of critically needed medical supplies, enabling our local health systems to provide uninterrupted critical care to those most in need during the onset of the pandemic. More than 212,000 pieces of personal protective equipment were donated between March and June 2020, including N95, disposable and handmade masks.

Local businesses flooded customer services inboxes and call centers asking how they could support our frontline health care heroes. As a result, more than 3,000 Rady Children's staff received warm meals, delicious snacks, energy drinks, grocery kits and comfort items to sustain their lifesaving work at the Hospital when the pressure was dialed up.

The generosity didn't stop there. A \$200,000 anonymous gift launched an employee assistance fund to aid staff undergoing hardship as a result of COVID-19. Collectively our community raised more than \$1 million in a few short weeks to support the Hospital's greatest needs.

If we had to live through a pandemic, we're grateful for the support system we have in the Rady Children's family to see our kids and the entire community through it—with ceaseless energy today and enduring hope for tomorrow.



To say that COVID-19 sent waves through Rady Children's is not to say anything remarkable in the global scheme of things. But what is remarkable is the fierce compassion, resilience and spirit of collaboration that rippled throughout our community the moment the pandemic hit. Rady Children's COVID-19 response has ranged from open and increased communications surrounding the virus to robust community fundraising efforts rapidly implemented to ensure the health and safety of our patients, families and frontline heroes.

In addition, Rady Children's received an outpouring of personal protective equipment, notes of encouragement and thanks, meals and snacks, and generous financial gifts from throughout the community. These donations were used to help develop 3D-printed nasal swabs and protective face shields, support necessary organizational adjustments such as adding patient isolation rooms, and bolster health and well-being resources for Hospital staff.

In 2019, when Ernest and Evelyn Rady made one of the largest single gifts to a children's hospital in the United States, Rady Children's President and CEO Patrick Frias called it a landmark day for pediatric health care. Their \$200 Million gift will help redevelop and expand Rady Children's campus and facilities—an investment that will usher in the next great age of innovative treatments, technologies and holistic, preventative practices designed with one objective: to provide every child with the most advanced, comprehensive care for generations to come.

Over the last three decades, the generosity of the Rady family and their commitment to the well-being of kids everywhere has elevated Rady Children's to the forefront of pediatric excellence and selective distinctive care. In the years prior to the start of the Rady Reimagine Fund, the Radys have donated over \$180 million to support the expansion of the medical campus exclusively dedicated to pediatric health care, including the establishment of the Rady Children's Institute for Genomic Medicine. This philanthropic leadership has also helped fill Rady Children's state-of-the-art medical facilities with doctors, nurses and teams of research specialists, in partnership with UC San Diego, who are recognized among the leaders in children's health care.

ADDING NEW DIMENSIONS TO EARLY DIAGNOSES

The work of the Helen and Will Webster Foundation 3D. Innovations (3DI) Lab at Rady Children's is focused on leveraging the power of next-generation technology to arm, amplify and accelerate the work of our trailblazing clinical team. Rady Children's experts provide surgical and clinical care to the region's most fragile patients, such as babies born with complicated heart and airway anatomy whose survival depends on precise, early intervention. Armed with on-site, first-to-market 3D modeling and printing resources, our team can examine and interact with their patients' anatomy prior to stepping foot in an operating room, equipping them with more thorough knowledge and greater confidence in the delicate work they undertake.

By forging research and development partnerships across San Diego's health care and scientific networks, creating custom prototypes and deploying proprietary software solutions, the Webster Foundation 3DI team helped Rady Children's and our surrounding community to create essential personal protective equipment at the height of the pandemic crisis. It is through the generosity of donors like the Helen and Will Webster Foundation that Rady Children's is embarking on this exciting frontier in pediatric health care-taking imagination to new heights.

PIONEERING PEDIATRIC GENOMIC MEDICINE

The 2014 opening of Rady Children's Institute for Genomic Medicine marked the beginning of a new era of pediatric medicine—not just locally in San Diego, but nationally and eventually globally. We are honored to champion enterprising, cure-oriented genomic research through the Marriott Foundation, starting with funding rapid whole-genome sequences to set a new standard of care where genomic medicine is available to every child who can benefit.

ENDURING SUPPORT


Sometimes the road to a healthy future is a long one, but a holistic approach to supporting a child's mental health is a head start on a thriving adulthood. Through the prioritization of prevention and early intervention practices at Rady Children's, a new age of pediatric health care is here—one in which mental health integration and continuity of care are thoughtfully held in the balance of every patient's journey to health and healing.

This year, Rady Children's embarked on a quest to create 10 new endowed chair positions, the highest honor the Hospital can bestow upon its top physicians and scientists. Two such positions were created to support, in perpetuity, mental and behavioral health initiatives and informed choices about treatment and care: the Davis Family Endowed Chair for Behavioral Health and the Galinson Family Endowed Chair in Supportive Care. Under the guidance and expertise of the appointed chair holders, Rady Children's mental and behavioral health and supportive care services are poised to transform outcomes and empower families from the inside out.

LEADING THE FIGHT AGAINST CHILDHOOD CANCERS

At Padres Pedal the Cause, we see it as our responsibility to invest in a future wherein the research, treatments and innovative minds that will save our children and preserve their health are within arm's reach. NEW HOPE FOR PECKHAM CENTER PATIENTS WITH BLOOD CANCERS

In another great stride in Rady Children's race to treat the most common pediatric cancer—acute lymphoblastic leukemia—we were among the first institutions in the United States certified to treat patients with a pioneering immunotherapy called Kymriah. A type of immunotherapy called chimeric antigen receptor (CAR) T-cell therapy, Kymriah genetically alters patients' blood cells to attack cancer cells. A potentially lifesaving therapy for patients with a previously poor prognosis, CAR-T therapy adds another powerful tool to Rady Children's cancer-fighting toolkit.

AN INVESTMENT IN MORE **TOMORROWS**







In a year unlike any other, we thank our donors who have invested in Rady Children's endowment. Donor investment in endowment provides Rady Children's with a steady stream of income in perpetuity and, this year, has helped us to brave the storm of COVID-19 with uninterrupted programs and continuity of care. Endowment market value includes donor and board designated endowed funds. Donor endowment is funded when the donor directs the principal to be invested and the earnings to be used for Rady Children's restricted or unrestricted purposes. Board endowment is funded at the direction of the Hospital Board from gifts contributed to Rady Children's without endowment restriction or other discretionary assets.


A LASTING COMMITMENT **TO CHILDREN**
