EXPANDING PSYCHOSOCIAL SERVICES TO ENHANCE WELL-BEING FOR KIDS BRAVING CANCER AND BLOOD DISORDERS

Promoting whole-child and family health means meeting physical, emotional, and social needs with a holistic approach. The Peckham Center team prioritizes the overall well-being of young cancer and blood disorder patients and their loved ones through outstanding, integrated programs that allow them to still be kids while in and out of the hospital—and focus on getting better. The kindness of generous friends like you enables enhancement and expansion of leading psychosocial programs that help children braving cancer and blood disorders thrive.

Among key priorities for philanthropic investment to strengthen psychosocial services at the Peckham Center:

HOPES FUND

Provides financial assistance to families receiving care at the Peckham Center who are unable to afford expenses not covered by insurance that arise during a lengthy cancer or blood disorder treatment. This can include food and taxi vouchers, gas cards, parking passes, wigs, miscellaneous emergency expenditures, pharmacy co-payments for critical medications and therapies, and even items such as space heaters for homes without heat. This special weekend is designed to provide a reprieve for teens during their long healing journeys and allow them to feel supported as they connect with peers facing similar life-changing experiences. Past participants share that this was a weekend they will never forget, and that it gave them confidence as they navigated cancer and blood disorder diagnoses. The generosity of our community makes this unique experience possible for deserving patients—from travel and lodging to meals and exclusive, behind-the-scenes experiences with Padres players. •

Jimi's Story

It was Thanksgiving Day when 10-year-old Jimi woke up with a bark-like cough his parents thought could be a respiratory infection, prompting a call to their pediatrician. They were directed immediately to the Emergency Department at Rady Children's, where Jimi's condition worsened, leading to the need for admission to the hospital. Three days later—as his fever and breathing issues persisted—he needed to be intubated.

Certain there was something underlying his severe illness, Jimi's care team initiated an evaluation that ultimately led to a diagnosis of acute myeloid leukemia (AML).

"We didn't know why his lungs were so sick, but they just couldn't get better because of the cancer," says Jimi's mom, Nicole. "He started chemotherapy the day after his AML diagnosis and continued despite still requiring intubation for the first 40 days."

E. coli was identified as the source of his infection, furthering his body's weakness. Intensive antibiotic therapy was integrated with chemotherapy to treat both problems at the same time. Eventually, Jimi was extubated, breathing on his own and getting stronger. Soon after, it was learned that Jimi would also require a bone marrow transplant.

"The blessing of all of this was that Jimi's little brother, Wref, was a 100 percent match and could serve as his bone marrow donor," says Nicole.

Jimi underwent a CT scan that clarified the source of the E.coli infection—perforations throughout his colon that would require surgery. His bone marrow transplant took place following surgery to repair the injuries to his colon and spleen.

"From that point, he recovered beautifully," says Nicole. "I thank those doctors and nurses in my prayers every single day. I can't imagine if we didn't have Rady Children's—if we lived somewhere and we didn't have access to it—because they saved Jimi's life."

Jimi also forged through intense physical therapy after his many procedures and treatments, totaling nine months in the hospital. But at each step of the way, his care team and child life specialists helped Jimi understand his diagnoses and treatments. They also kept Jimi connected to his friends at home by educating them on what he was going through and setting up a "monkey in my chair"—a stuffed monkey that sat at Jimi's desk at school while he was away and wore a backpack where classmates could place letters to Jimi to stay in touch with him.







"The monkey still sits on his bed today," says Nicole. "It's a sweet reminder that he wasn't alone in this."

Since recovering, Jimi has had a chance to enjoy special experiences and engagements with the San Diego Padres and Seals through the Peckham Center's psychosocial programs.

Nicole says Jimi still expresses missing the hospital and wanting to go back to the friends he made in his nurses and doctors. "They made such an impact on him and provided genuine love and care for him and our whole family. We can't repay that."


